Meeting of the IQAC of **Govt. Bikram College of Commerce, Patiala** was conducted under the guidance of Chairperson Prof. (Dr.) Kusum Lata, Principal on 05-11 2022 in the principal office at 12:10 PM. A total of 14 Members attended the meeting along with student Nominee IQAC Coordinator Dr. Vaneeta Rani discussed the agenda of the meeting as per DPI © Punjab office memo no. 403663 Colleges (3)/1422 dated 21-10-2022 and the following points emerge from the discussion:

### 1) Institutional views on learner centric education

- a. Multidisciplinary education: Multidisciplinary education is the need of the hour. Our college is already providing learning in various fields such as course in computers and certificate courses in business etiquettes and professionalism, IT Enabled Services and Retail and Sales Management.
- b. Adoption of Academic Bank of credits: Academic bank of credit is a good initiative taken by the higher education institutes under NEP 2020. Under this our colleges students are getting registered on the <a href="www.abc.gov.in">www.abc.gov.in</a> 70% of students have already registered for the same and rest are under process.
- c. Adoption of Multiple Entry and exit system: Members are highly in favor of introducing multiple entry and exit system. It will benefit the student through multy disciplinary learning.
- d. Adoption of guidelines of NHQEF and curriculum and credit framework for undergraduate programmes: - Members of the IQAC are in favor of adoption of guidelines of NHQEF and curriculum and credit framework for undergraduate programmes as it provides comprehensive framework that will be comparable with international quality standard. This will definitely change the face of Indian education system through experiential and skill based learning.

#### 2) Institutional Preparedness and views on digital learning

- a. Open distance learning and online programmes: The College is fully prepared for online learning programmes. The students are guided about various eresources. Teachers are also attending online FDPs from time to time.
- b. Syayam and other MOOCS programmes and their relevance: A number of faculty members have appeared in final test on New Education Policy 2020 after attending 7 days FDP on syayam portal. Some of the faculty members have also registered for MOOCS.

#### 3) Industry institute collaboration

a. Internship/Apprenticeship embedded programmes: - Our college students enrolled for office management vocational course go for one month training. Members gave the viewpoints so that students can get internship that will boost up their moral.

- b. Alumni Connect: The College has registered alumni association named 'Bikram Alumni Global Association' (BAGA). Every year college organizes annual get together of alumni Home-Coming. This annual function will be held on 3<sup>rd</sup> December, 2022. Alumni executive meeting was held on 01-11-2022, in which it has been decided to give scholarships to needy students and provide 3 Air conditioners for Saheed Bhaat Singh Hall.
- c. MOU with industry for internship/Research/Entrepreneurship/Employment: -The objective to sign Memorandum of Understanding (MOU's) with companies and NGOs is to stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance the academic standard, professional & social skills and intellectual life of our students. Our College has signed eight MOU's with various industries and organizations.

- Research and development cell in every College: We are planning to establish Research and development cell in our College.
- 4) Institutional awareness and preparedness on academic research and internationalization:
  - a. Academic and research collaboration between Indian and foreign higher education institutions-institutional efforts: - Maximum teachers of our College are Doctorate. Some are Pursuing Ph.D. Senior Teachers are also guiding Ph.D. scholars. Teachers are also writing articles for research journals. Our Colleges is putting efforts for the academic collaboration with university and Colleges. The College has tied up with Jagat Guru Nanak Dev Open University, Patiala for Certificate Courses.
  - Ranking of institutions: The College is planning to get ranking through NIRF in this session.
  - c. Adoption of guidelines of UGC on institutional development plan: The College is following the guidelines of UGC on institutional development plan.
  - d. Accreditation: The College got was accredited in the year 2005 and got B+ grade. At present we are preparing for 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle of accreditation.

e. Faculty training: - All faculty members are motivated to update themselves by improving their skills from time to time. Faculty members attend online and offline faculty development programme.

## 5) Indian knowledge system

- a. Courses in Indian Languages: Our College is Government College and is affiliated with Punjabi University, Patiala. The College is offering courses like B.Com, M.Com and B.C.A. as per the norms of Punjabi University, Patiala students can opt for Punjabi or English as medium of their study in undergraduate commerce courses.
- Embedding Indian knowledge system in curriculum: The curriculum is decided by the members in the meeting of Board of Studies Punjabi University, Patiala.

## 6) Institutional efforts to promote employability:

a. Establishment and progress of Placement Cell: - The College has well established Placement Cell which is taking care of employability needs of the students. The cell is also arranging career guidance lectures for them.

# b. Progress of career guidance cell: -

- GSA industries visited in our college campus on 08-02-2022 and conducted a placement drive in which they shortlisted 11 students from computer department.
- ii. NIIT visited our college campus on 04-03-2022, conducted a placement drive for recruitment in ICICI BANK for the post of relationship manager in which 22 students of commerce stream has been shortlisted
- iii. An MOU was finalized with BFSI on 01-04-2022 and they started certified program of BAJAJ FINANCIAL SERVICES in the college. 45 students got registered in above program and successfully completed the first session of 45 days.
- iv. C -3 career consultants visited our college campus on 21-02-2022 in which Sh. Manik Raj Singla had delivered a lecture on career guidance to boost up the knowledge of students.
- v. District Bar Association, Patiala under the leadership of Sh. Umesh Kumar Ghai (ADV.) delivered inspirational and motivational lectures to our students in our college campus on 04-04-2022 and also emphasized legal issues pertaining to court cases.
- vi. DR. Roopsi from Employment Branch of D.C. office conducted an essay writing competition in our college campus on 20-04-2022 where she distributed participation certificates to our students.
- vii. A lecture on career guidance was conducted in the college on 07-10-2022 in which Mrs. Unnati Goel (Company Secretary, Aggarsain Fibers Pvt. Ltd.

- Samana) delivered lecture on topic –CS A CAREER WITH ENDLESS OPPORTUNITIES.
- viii. A lecture on career guidance was conducted in the college on 31-10-2022 in which Smt. Seema Aggarwal (Chairperson, Patiala branch of Charted Accountants) delivered a lecture on topic-Mega Career counseling program.
- ix. Further, in 3<sup>rd</sup> week of November 2022, a faculty development program is scheduled to be conducted by Jaipuria Institution of Management Noida in which the faculty will be apprised of leveraging technology in classrooms. - c. Linkages with society organizations to promote employability: District Bar Association, Patiala under the leadership of Sh. Umesh Kumar Ghai (Advocate) delivered inspirational and motivational lectures to our students in our college campus on 04-04-2022 and motivated student to join legal profession. Our Institution has collaboration with Rotary Club and formed Rotaract Club for Social Services.
- d. Best practices of College to promote self-employment: The College organizes extension lectures on self employment from time to time.
