POLICY FOR DISABLED STUDENTS

Govt. Bikram College of Commerce , Patiala has framed a policy for the disabled students to provide an environment where differently able students with a Disability are appropriately supported and encouraged and are free from discrimination or harassment. This policy applies to all students admitted in College. The admissions of the disabled students is done according to the reservation policy of the State Government .The College will strive to ensure that no student is disadvantaged in his/her participation in any aspect of college life as a result of a disability. The Policy commits to provide a study environment where differently able students will get equal opportunities and face no discrimination or harassment. The Policy ensure that people with disabilities have same rights as the rest of the community and promotes recognition and acceptance of these rights within the campus community.

1. Objectives:

- To promote and foster an environment which encourages positive and unprejudiced attitude towards students with disability.
- Implement procedures for any reasonable adjustments needed by students with a disability.
- Ensure that positive and practical steps are undertaken to enable students with disabilities to seek employment or student enrolment within the College.
- Employ all reasonable and appropriate teaching strategies and methods to demonstrate essential skills or knowledge to differently able students.
- Ensure that the needs of students with a disability are met in relation to the physical environment of campus, including buildings, facilities and grounds.
- The college has provision of Ramps and Wheel chairs.

2. Procedure:

- Filing of request for reasonable adjustment of
 - a) A process/policy/procedure
 - b) Exams adjustment
 - c) Disability support workers.
 - d) Assistance technology such as equipment/physical aids.

3. Assessment of the differently able students based on the provision of appropriate medical documentation and a detailed interview. Documents provided by students to support his/her disability must be dated and signed by the appropriate health authority.

4. The documentation provided should be specific and state:

- The impairment, mental health or medical condition.
- Indicate whether the Disability is permanent, temporary, or fluctuating.
- Clearly identify the health professional and their credentials.

5. Examination adjustments for students with disabilities:

The College will make adjustments in examinations for students with a disability (including students with chronic medical conditions), to provide them with an equitable opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and competency for assessment purposes. Alternate arrangements for examinations are recommended such as:

- Extension of time
- Use of assistive technology
- A separate room
- Alternative formatting of exam papers.
